- Lessons missed MUST be made up throughout the term otherwise they are forfeited. Makeups cannot be done on test week. Maximum 2 makeup lessons per student per term.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To make sure you get the most out of your Aussie Skate experience, please keep the following in mind:

- This program is NON-REFUNDABLE. Decisions for all other credit requests are made at the manager's discretion.
- Timetable Changes: LCC Ice Rink reserves the right to make class changes as necessary. Classes may be combined in cases where numbers are low.
- No Responsibility: The activities provided in this centre have a certain amount of risk attached. By entering the centre, our patrons and their guardians accept there is a degree of risk and release the centre from any responsibility or legal liability associated with participating in an activity or actions of other patrons present or participants in an activity. Helmets, elbow, and knee pads are available from skate hire.
- Children aged 14 years and under cannot be left in the Sports Complex unattended.
- Make up lessons: Missed lessons can be made up by attending a class at an alternative time (maximum of two make-up lessons allowed per term). Make up lessons must be used during the same term, or they are forfeited. Make up lessons cannot be done on test week.
- Enrolments open on the day after the previous term's finish date.
- New enrolments and re-enrolments close at the end of week 2.

LEARN TO SKATE WITH AUSSIE SKATE

THE AUSSIE SKATE PROGRAM COVERS EVERYTHING FROM BEGINNING STEPS TO JUMPS & SPINS

The Aussie Skate program is a nationally recognised learn to skate syllabus designed to teach the skating skills required to be a confident and capable skater.

Our skate school is the place to start if you want to find your feet on the ice. It is designed to enable skaters to progress into the varying disciplines of ice skating, such as figure skating, hockey etc.

The Aussie Skate terms run according to the NSW public school terms.



HOW DO I ENROL IN AUSSIE SKATE?

To sign up for Aussie Skate you need to be a current member of the Liverpool Catholic Club.

Adult membership is \$7 and Junior membership is \$4.

See the reception staff at the rink to fill out an enrolment form.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST AND WHAT DOES IT INCLUDE?

Aussie Skate runs according to NSW school terms at \$18.90 per week with an accredited coach. (eg. 9 weeks x \$18.90 = \$170.10).

This is an upfront payment and includes one 30 minute lesson per week with a qualified coach as well as additional practice time either before or after your lesson (only within Aussie Skate times).

A second 30 minute class is available per week at half price. This is an upfront payment of \$75.60.

Active Kids Vouchers can be redeemed here. T&Cs apply.

WHAT ARE ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHERS?

An active kids voucher is a \$50 voucher provided by Service NSW for children, to use towards a sport. Log onto Service NSW to redeem your child's voucher.

Active Kids Vouchers must be registered in the student's name. See voucher for expiration. Terms & Conditions apply

WHAT IS ICE SKATING AUSTRALIA (ISA)?

All students need to register with Ice Skating Australia (ISA), which covers skaters for insurance as part of the Aussie Skate Program.

2026 Initial Registration is \$40 (incl GST)

This expires each calendar year. 2026 Annual Renewal is \$30 (Incl GST).

The ISA website is aussieskate.au. Click Aussie Skate and follow the prompts.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

Skaters need to come prepared with:

- Your LCC membership card. You MUST swipe your card at reception before your lesson.
- Your own skates OR you can use our hire skates FREE.
- Comfortable, warm layers of clothing.
- Gloves, long socks and/or tights.
- Helmets, knee & elbow pads are available at skate hire.
- ISA invoice receipt.

WHAT IS TEST WEEK?

Each student is given constructive feedback on how they are progressing, in the areas they have excelled in and those areas that might need a bit more practice.

Each level has at least 6 elements that must be achieved before progressing to the next level. This can sometimes take more than one term to achieve.

Upon passing a level each student is also awarded an Aussie Skate certificate and badge as a memento of their skating achievements.

HOW MANY SKATERS ARE IN EACH CLASS?

Aussie Skate is a group based program with approximately 10 students per level. Higher levels will have less students due to more movement on ice. When make-up lessons occur, this number will vary by 1-2 students.

ARE THERE CLASSES FOR ADULTS?

Yes! We offer Adults Only classes for those aged 18 and older. Please consult the ice rink staff for any inquiries and enrolment details.

ARE THERE LESSONS FOR HOCKEY BEGINNERS?

Yes! The Hockey curriculum has been designed to teach the students the fundamentals of hockey skating skills. The skaters will learn to become more agile and to maneuver faster on the ice. Skaters must complete up to Basic 2 before becoming eligible to join.
